Veneered Blackback

Appearance

The black primer film creates the visually perfect background for the open areas.

Black glue penetration cannot occur! The slight gleam of the black areas due to the transparent glue disappears with the surface treatment (varnish, oil, etc.). Kaindl Blackback is suitable for all rustic wood species, except for Historic Oak and Antique Oak.

Format

2.800 x 2.070 x 8 / 15 / 18 mm (particleboard substrate)

2.800 x 2.070 x 18 mm (MDF substrate)

Use

Especially for 0.6 mm thick veneers, blackback is the only way to avoid visually disruptive glue penetration.



Kaindl samples are supplied automatically from the sample stock, without consideration of the wood's texture or colouring. These samples represent the characteristics of the respective wood species; however, they do not establish any automatic claim to the appearance and quality of panel deliveries. The selection for projects takes place separately, after consultation with our relevant department.
