§ 1 - Veneer dimensions

The following dimensions apply to all veneers unless expressly agreed otherwise in writing:

Length dimensions:

Minimum length: 2900 mm

Maximum calculable length: 3100 mm

Width dimensions:

Minimum width: 100 mm

Veneer thickness

Minimum thickness: 0.5 mm

It is hereby expressly agreed that the exact net veneer thickness must be stated in the delivery note and invoice for each veneer delivered. This also applies to all special thicknesses up to 1.5 mm.

§ 2 - Moisture content

The supplier undertakes to supply M. Kaindl OG with veneers with a moisture content of 8-14%.

Moisture contents outside of this range require the express written acceptance of the purchaser.

§ 3 - Packaging and goods designation

Dimension

It is hereby agreed that veneers shall be delivered stacked on wooden pallets.

Accordingly, wooden pallets must be stable in design and fitted with nailed scantlings (foot pallets). The scantlings must have a minimum height of 8 cm.

The packaging unit = pallet / package must be wrapped in plastic sheeting and covered (protected against moisture). A wooden pallet must be placed on top of the covering sheeting. The pallet / package must be bound with steel or plastic strapping (at least 3 times)

The height of the packaging unit shall not exceed 1,200 mm.

The width of the packaging unit must be <1,100 mm. The length of the packaging unit is derived from the length of the purchased veneers but shall not exceed 4,000 mm overall.

Labelling on the veneer pallet

The packaging unit = pallet / package must bear a label on the outside with the following data:

- Wood type,
- Quality,
- Volume (m²)

The font size used for the label must be legible to the fork-lift truck driver; minimum font height 20 mm.

Inserts and material designation

If the delivery contains flitch stock each flitch must be clearly separated from the others, for instance using a strip of veneer.

Every package must be bound at least twice and contain a label stating the following information:

- Flitch number,
- Consecutive package number,
- Length of the veneer package,
- Width of the veneer package,
- Volume (m²),
- Number of sheets in the package

Unless expressly agreed otherwise in writing each package must contain at least 32 sheets

§ 4 - Certificate of Origin, Certificates, Declarations

The supplier undertakes to provide for all delivered goods a long-term supplier's declaration for products with preferential origin status.

The supplier shall make available to M. Kaindl OG any and all types of certification relating to the company or material.

The supplier shall confirm once per year by means of the form "Erklärung/ Declaration" that the goods delivered by him to M. Kaindl OG are of safe origin.

§ 5 - General Purchasing Conditions of M. Kaindl OG

The version valid at the time of purchasing is an integrated component of the order and is herewith approved and acknowledged. Please visit www.kaindl.com to review the currently valid version.

§ 6 - Place of fulfilment, place of jurisdiction and applicable law

The place of fulfilment for all deliveries and services rendered is the recipient plant in question; the exclusive place of jurisdiction for all disputes arising from contractual agreements between us and the supplier is the appropriate competent court in the provincial capital of Salzburg; this agreement and any disputes arising from it are subject to Austrian law. The applicability of the **UN Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods** is excluded by mutual agreement.

The invalidity of individual stipulations of this agreement shall not affect the validity of the remaining stipulations
