Transport and Storage/Stacking



Kaindl Flooring products should always be stored in a level, draught-free and dry room. During transportation, it is important that the packaging units are not unnecessarily exposed to wind and weather.

Stacking of packaging units

There are two essential different characteristics to consider.

1. Pallet height

small pallet $= \le 40$ units per pallet high pallet = > 40 units per pallet

2. Products with or without Silent Underlay (PE-FOAM)

Maximum pallet height of products with Silent Underlay (PE-Foam)

- small pallet max. 4 pallets on top of each other
- high pallet max. 3 pallets on top of each other

Maximum pallet height of products without Silent Underlay (PE-Foam)

- small pallet max. 5 pallets on top of each other
- high pallet max. 4 pallets on top of each other

Those specifications refer to original packing units. The sub-floor (bottom) must be level and able to take the load. The packaging units must be stacked exactly on top of each other. Damaged packing units or pallets should not be stacked on top of each other.
